The restructuring and expansion works of Hospital São Francisco de Araraquara were intended to provide an innovative and welcoming atmosphere in a building classified as a historical heritage.

The intervention restored and preserved the historic facade, the noble hall, chapel and care area, enhancing the local culture, while creating spaces and conditions with high quality standards that guarantee the well-being and safety of patients with technology. and state of the art equipment.

The new structure of the hospital has 22 medical specialities and 47 beds, having been created a maternity hospital, Surgical Center, Intensive Care Unit (ICU), Special Care Unit, Cardiology Diagnostic Care Center (CADIC) and Advanced Center for Oncology (CAON).

Construction management was handled by Engexpor.
